On 08.04.2026, this Court, on finding that six persons had violated the Court's orders and have proceeded to continue with the construction, notwithstanding the clear restraint of this Court and a consequent order passed by the Municipal Corporation, issued notices to all six of them, out of whom four have been served.

Out of those four who have been served with the notice, one Dr. Vanlalhruii (respondent No.1) has appeared through Mr. Johny L. Tochwawng, learned counsel, who is yet to file his Vakalatnama.

Mr. Johny L. Tochwawng submits that he shall be filing his response to this application in the shape of a reply to the show cause notice to explain why contempt proceedings be not initiated against the respondent No.1.

The rest of the three, who have been served, are given one more opportunity to appear before this Court through their accredited counsel for explaining their cause.

Mr. Joseph L. Renthlei, learned Amicus has also offered to serve the respondent Nos.2 to 4 by way of *dasti*.

The Registry shall provide a format of notice to the learned Amicus, who shall have it served on respondent Nos.2 to 4.

The Registry shall communicate to the Officer-in-Charge of the concerned Police Station for the service of notice on respondent Nos.5 & 6, who shall report to this Registry.

Mr. Joseph L. Renthlei, learned Amicus shall also find out the correct and present addresses of the respondent Nos.5 & 6 and in that event, we may direct for issuance of notice to the respondent Nos.5 & 6 thereafter on their correct and present addresses.

Let this matter come up for consideration on **22.07.2026**.

We make it very clear that in the interregnum, any construction activity in the prohibited area, as directed by this Court earlier, would be viewed very seriously.
