Heard Mr. J.C. Lalnunsanga, learned counsel for the petitioner, who has filed the instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of an appropriate writ or order to the respondent Nos. 5 to 8 by assailing the impugned eviction notice dated 27.01.2026, whereby the petitioner

is illegally evicted from her residence at Tanhril, Aizawl.

The instant writ petition is also filed for quashing/setting aside the Mizoram Police Press Statement No. F.14018/1/25-PR/19 dated 27.01.2026, issued by respondent No. 3, and for the registration of a case against the persons who had committed the act of vandalism and destruction of the properties of the petitioner, as well as for the payment of compensation amounting to Rs. 7,61,130/- (rupees seven lakhs sixty one thousand one hundred and thirty) on the destruction of the properties belonging to the petitioner and her family members.

The learned counsel further submits that the Apex Court in the case of People's Union for Civil Liberties & Anr. Vs. State of Maharashtra & Ors reported in 2023 INSC 833, issued guidelines regarding the press releases made by the police. Further, the Apex Court in the case of Tehseen S. Poonwalla Vs. Union of India & Ors reported in 2018 9 SCC 501 had condemned vigilantism and directed the mandatory registration of an FIR regarding such actions.

Having heard the submissions made by the learned counsel, this court finds it appropriate to issue notice of motion to the respondents.

Ms. Lalnunhlui, learned Govt. Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the State

respondent Nos. 1 to 4.

Notice to be issued through registered post with A/D card within 3 working days to respondent Nos. 5 to 8, returnable by 2 (two) week.

As sought for, list the matter on **09.03.2026**.
